If you are in Lake County, you may be eligible for free #COVID19 testing through the Health Services Department in collaboration with Verily's Project Baseline.

What are the exact criteria for testing eligibility?

The screening questions were designed using public health guidelines to assess an individual's level of risk for COVID-19. This program is currently focused on testing high-risk populations as advised by public health authorities. This includes those who may be exhibiting symptoms and have other risk factors.

Who is administering the swab collection onsite?

Qualified healthcare providers, including nurses, are administering nasal swab collection procedure.

What does the process look like?

Who is processing the tests?

The tests are being processed by Quest Diagnostics.

How much does testing cost?

Testing is provided at no cost to individuals, whether they have insurance or not.

How quickly are results returned?

The labs performing testing have estimated that those tested will receive results within 2-5 days, however this may be longer depending on test processing. Lab capacity has been extremely limited in the early days of state-wide testing, and that capacity is steadily increasing over time.
